Koala Kids Foundation works hard to provide the small things that make a big difference to the lives of more than 1,700 children and young adults undergoing cancer treatment. These children are treated at The Royal Children's Hospital and Monash Children's Hospital, Peter MacCallum Cancer Centre and at nine regional facilities around Victoria.

These 'small things' include educational activities and consumables which help distract children and young adults from the pain associated with the cancer journey, provide some comfort and keep them connected with their education and the outside world.

We also work hard to support whole families while their child or sibling is undergoing treatment particularly siblings who struggle when their families' lives are turned upside down.

Koala Kids Foundation does not duplicate any programs or activities provided by other charities for children with cancer. We are a volunteer driven organisation with minimal administrative costs and operate from rent-free office and warehouse space. We source all consumables and programs in kind, at cost or heavily discounted and most of our services are provided pro bono.

Although we receive generous donations, we still need to raise funds to purchase much-needed items that bring children and their families a little happiness into long hospital days.
